

MUNICH TRAVEL GUIDE

Munich is worth a visit – and not just for a holiday. Many business travelers come to the Bavarian state capital for a few days – for example to attend Research & Results or one of the other major shows held here. We have put together some tips and useful information for how you can make the most of your stay in München.

GETTING HERE AND GETTING AROUND

The public transport network will get you virtually everywhere you want to go in and around Munich. Reckon with a train ride of about 45 minutes from the airport to the central station (Hauptbahnhof). You can get to the MOC conference center in Freimann, where Research & Results is held, on the U6 (blue line) underground. The Messe München trade show center is on the U2 (red line).

- The MVV public transport app provides you with all the information you will need, and you can also use it to buy your ticket online. So download it now: [IOS >](#) | [Android >](#)
- If you're going to be using public transport a lot, a day pass or three-day pass may make sense for you. Details at: www.mvv-muenchen.de
- Don't forget to validate your ticket after buying it! Singles, stripe cards and day passes all have to be punched in the machines at the entrance to the underground system.

There are several car-sharing concepts at work in Munich.

- [DriveNow](#) (BMW and Mini) and [car2go](#) (Mercedes, Smart) are even available from the airport, for a very reasonable price.

FOOD AND DRINK

You will find numerous Bavarian and other restaurants in Munich. We have put together some suggestions below:

Typical Bavarian

- The "Fraunhofer" at number 9 Fraunhoferstraße (inner city, Glockenbachviertel district), www.fraunhofertheater.de
- The "Wirtshaus in der Au" at 51 Lilienstraße (inner city, Au district) www.wirtshausinderau.de
- The "Augustiner-Keller" at 52 Arnulfstraße (inner city, near the Hauptbahnhof), with one of the city's best-known beer gardens in summer www.augustinerkeller.de
- The "Schneider Bräuhaus" at number 7 Tal (inner city, near Marienplatz) www.schneiderbrauhaus.de

Special treats

- The "Schmalznudel" (Café Frischhut) at number 8 Prälat-Zistl-Straße is right next to the Viktualienmarkt – where you can also enjoy all sorts of delicacies at the stands or a nice cold beer. It is known far and wide for its famous deep-fried pastries.
- You can get a fantastic curried sausage till late at night at the Bergwolf (17 Fraunhoferstraße, Mo – Th till 2 a.m., Fr and Sa till 4 a.m.)
- "Mustafa's Gemüse Kebap" – well known to Berlin natives – has been serving its kebabs in Munich since August 2017, at 21-24 Stachus. Prepare to stand in line!

ALREADY GOT PLANS FOR THE EVENING?

How about a visit to "Schumann's Tagesbar", owned by the famous Munich cocktail connoisseur Charles Schumann? And on the first floor is the "Les Fleurs du Mal" bar, where you can order individually customized drinks. 6-7 Odeonsplatz, www.schumanns.de

Another option? Sure!:

- **PUSSER's New York Bar**: Typical American at 9 Falkenturmstraße, open daily from 6/7 p.m.
- **Bar Tabacco**: Cultivated drinks and sophisticated atmosphere can be found at number 8 Hartmannstraße

Perhaps you'd like to go to the movies. We've got a couple of special cinemas with **films in OV** here for you:

- Cinema, Nymphenburger Straße 31
- Museum Lichtspiele, Lilienstraße (near the Deutsche Museum)

If you are familiar with the **German** language

- **Gloria Filmpalast** at Stachus: food, drink and loads of space.
- **ASTOR Cinema Lounge** in the Bayerischer Hof hotel: only a small selection of films, but a luxurious cinema experience with ambiance and delicious beverages.

GET TO KNOW MUNICH IN 24 HOURS

The classics: Marienplatz, the Rathaus, the Alter Peter, Viktualienmarkt, the Frauenkirche, rickshaw rides through the English Garden, Nymphenburg Palace and the Chinese Tower.

Topical city tours through weißer Stadtvogel: e.g. Myths & Legends, Bavarian delicacies or the Night Watchman Tour: www.stadtvogel.de

Then it's off to the lake! The lakes Starnberg, Ammersee and Tegernsee are all within 30 to 60 minutes from town.

Want to hit some golf balls? No problem:

- Right near the conference center is Riem golf course, built inside the horse racetrack: www.gcriem.de
- In the north of Munich you can practice at the City Golf Center Freimann: www.citygolfcenter.de
- Or if you've got time for a round, the famous golf club: www.gc-eichenried.de isn't far from the airport.

Too much like hard work? You prefer to relax and enjoy?

- Take a stroll through the Olympiapark to the neighboring BMW World and BMW Museum. You will find all the events happening in the Olympiapark here: www.olympiapark.de/de/veranstaltungen-tickets
- What can we say about the English Garden that hasn't already been said? It offers so many gorgeous places in the midst of Munich. You can get there easily with the U3/U6, for example, getting off at Giselastraße, Universität or Münchner Freiheit.
